Our escalator systems are engineered with modular component configurations to meet various requirements, making them perfectly adapted for heavy traffic loads in different usage conditions.

Maximized truss protection

The truss design with open steel profiles offers optimal protection through double- or triple-layer coating or hot-dip galvanization, effectively resisting long-term corrosion. The vibration-isolated end supports minimize sound transmission to the building.

Performing in all climate conditions

All components are designed to withstand humidity, heat, ice, salt, and sand. The optionally galvanized truss and components, heating features, and microprocessor-controlled chain lubrication guarantee reliable operation in any environment.



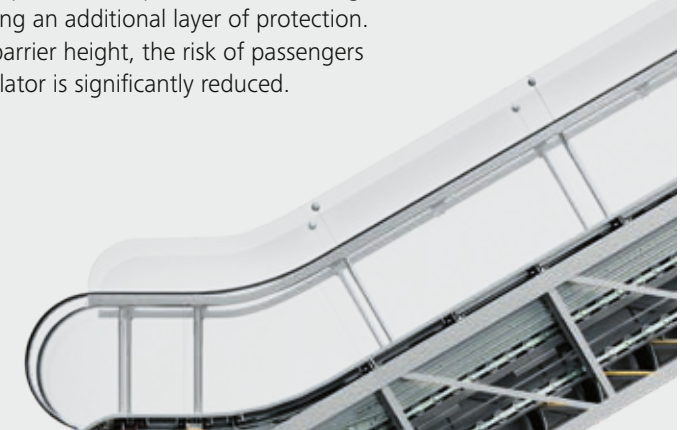
Schindler Ultra UV protection

The Schindler Ultra UV utilizes UV-C light for disinfection, which is invisible to the human eye, to treat handrails during operation efficiently and without damage to the environment. For escalators with heavy traffic, there's also a Pro version with enhanced UV-C lights.



Anti-Fall panel

Improper use of escalators happens occasionally. Our innovative Anti-Fall product complements the existing balustrade, providing an additional layer of protection. By increasing the barrier height, the risk of passengers falling off the escalator is significantly reduced.

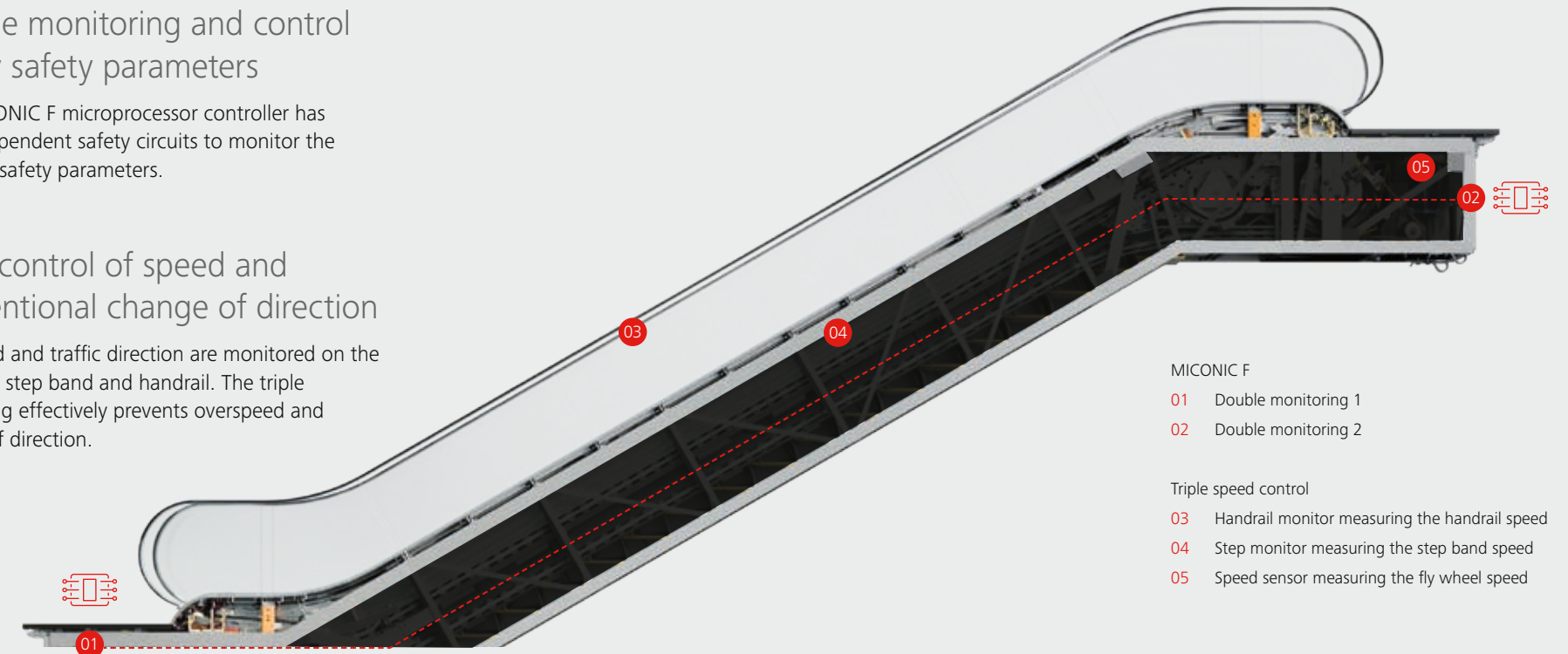


Double monitoring and control of key safety parameters

The MICONIC F microprocessor controller has two independent safety circuits to monitor the essential safety parameters.

Triple control of speed and unintentional change of direction

The speed and traffic direction are monitored on the fly wheel, step band and handrail. The triple monitoring effectively prevents overspeed and change of direction.

Long-lasting drive shaft design

Schindler's escalator drive shaft design improves performance and durability with its two-part structure: a fixed steel axle and a rotating hollow shaft. This separation of flexural and torsional forces helps maintain optimal functionality in high-traffic areas.

Dependable drive chain, step chain and rollers

Our step chain and drive chain are designed with a high breaking load and low pin pressure paired with durable rollers, to ensure a comfortable travel experience for passengers.

Break-resistant aluminum compact steps

Steps are one of the most important safety component and we produced them in-house. Our aluminum mono-block step provides significantly higher break resistance at substantially lower step weight compared to multipart compound steel steps.

Effective passenger guidance

Schindler 9300 is designed to guide all passengers safely on their journey. Full visual guidance is provided by moving LED direction indicators, fire-resistant step demarcations, yellow signal combs, and LED step gap lighting.

Ergonomic and reinforced handrail

Our new ergonomic handrail design combines high flexibility with strength for exceptional durability and a long service life. Even small hands can comfortably grip the handrail.

Standing safe

Innovative safety features, including slip-resistant steps with optional screw-free safety demarcations, aesthetic skirt brushes, and a skirt anti-friction coating, collectively provide a safe foot hold.

Effective braking system to reduce the risk of falling

Schindler's innovative braking system is designed to minimize the risk of passengers falling during emergency stops. The system adapts the brake torque to the direction of travel, enhancing safety for all passengers.

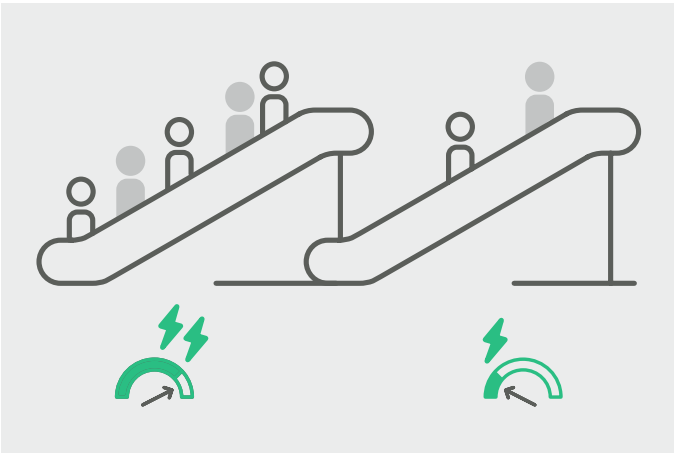

State-of-the-art drive system

Our advanced drive system maximizes energy efficiency and enables higher rise and extended service life. It integrates motors with IE3 premium efficiency or IE4 super premium efficiency alongside high-efficiency helical gears. An energy efficiency class of above A+++ can be achieved, above ISO 25745-3 standards.



Digital maintenance solutions

Our digital services offer clear insights into your equipment's health, reducing callouts by up to 40%* and downtimes by up to 34%*. Remote monitoring allows us to optimize our technicians' trips, which contributes to lowering maintenance-related carbon emissions.

*Callout and downtime reduction rates are based on the outcomes observed at a site after one year of operation, where all Schindler escalators installed were connected via the Schindler Cube.



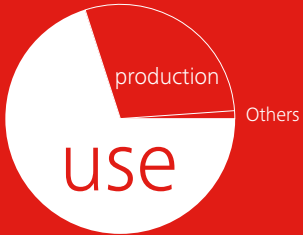
End-of-life treatment

We prioritize the use of environmentally friendly materials, ensuring that up to 97% of the metals in our escalators are recyclable at the end of their service life. We're also increasing the use of recycled aluminum for components such as steps and pallets.

Energy-efficient solutions to lower carbon footprint

The majority of CO2 emissions result from the daily operation of escalators. Therefore, prioritizing the reduction of energy consumption during the use phase is key for minimizing impact.

Our aluminum steps with minimized CO2 footprint

Our aluminum steps and pallets, produced in-house, are among the most durable in the industry. They can even meet very specific customer's specification requirements.



Smart operation management

Use only the energy needed. When the system detects low volumes, the ECO Mode can reduce energy consumption by up to 25% at nominal speed. The stop & go or stand-by speed operation saves additional energy, and extra energy is generated from downward travel.

Breathe new life into your buildings. Our repair and modernization solutions ensure reliable and predictable performance at any stage of the product's life. Upgrading escalators with energy-saving options or rebuilding them within the existing truss can significantly boost equipment performance and efficiency.
